# LIVESTOCK CLASSES GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All livestock must be on the grounds as stated, in the respective sections.
- 2. Stalls are provided on the grounds for the stock, on a first come basis. The exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding and hay.
- 3. No entry fee is required for championship, or special prizes, unless otherwise specified in the conditions governing the prize. All first prize animals must compete for their respective championships. Entry fees must be made prior to July 14th, 2019.
- 4. Late entries are accepted after July 14th, 2019. Late Entry Fees will be \$20.00 per class and will not be catalogued. Stalling will not be guaranteed.
- 5. All animals competing in classes which require more than one animal to make the exhibit must have entered and shown in their respective sections for single animals.

#### PRIZE MONEY:


Prize money will be paid from first to fifth placing in classes in the following amounts:

#### **CLASSES**

- 1. Bull calf born on or after January 1, 2018. Minimum of three months of age on the day of judging.
- 2. Yearling bull born January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018.
- 3. Grand and Reserve Champion Bull—Rosettes.
- SUPREME BULL
- 4. 4H Beef Heifer, must be shown in a current 4H year
- 5. Heifer calf born on or after January 1, 2019. Minimum of three months of age on day of judging.
- 6. Yearling heifer born January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018.
- 7. Junior and Reserve Junior Champion Female—Rosettes.
- 8. Female born January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017 with her own 2019 natural, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf to be shown as a unit. The calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in breeders herd and get of sire as well as current year calf class.
- 9. Female born prior to January 1st, 2017 with her own natural calf at foot. Female and Calf to be shown as a unit. The calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in breeders held and get of sire as well as current calf class.
- 10. Present Future, yearling and cow calf pair
- 11. **Senior and Reserve Senior Champion Female**—Rosettes.
- SUPREME FEMALE

- 6. Livestock must <u>not</u> be removed from the grounds before the times stated in the sections rules.
- 7. All breed classes will be shown in the ring and must be halter broke and under control at all times.
- 8. Exhibitors must be ready to bring their animals into the ring when called to do so.
- 9. All livestock on Exhibition grounds are at owners risk from fire/other causes.
- 10. In the absence of competition in any section the judge shall exercise their discretion as to whether they will award the first, second or any prize.
- 11. All particulars on the entry form must be completed for registered cattle.
- 12. All cattle competing for prizes in the open show must be registered in their respective Canadian Herd books in the name of the exhibitor. Registration certificates should be available so they may be checked by the committee if they so wish.
- 13. The Livestock Committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules and regulations.

- 14. Numbers will be issued at the office upon registration . All numbers must be worn by <u>ALL</u> exhibitors front and back.
- 15. Entry must be made by the deadline of July 14th, 2019 to be catalogued.
- 16. Enter fair grounds at East Gate. Trailers to be parked on the East side.
- 17. All persons entering the gate must have a gate pass.

#### **ENTRY DEADLINE:**

Friday, July 14th, 2019 at 5 PM.

#### **ARRIVAL OF ANIMALS:**

All animals must be stalled by 8 AM on Monday, July 15th, 2019.

#### **REMOVAL TIME:**

All animals must remain on the grounds until 6 PM Monday, July 15th, 2019.
